• HOW TO MAKE A TOILET PAPER ROLL CATERPILLAR •

A toilet paper caterpillar is a great activity for children. These cardboard creatures are easy to make and lots of fun to play with and easy to make together!

• SUPPLIES NEEDED •

- Toilet paper tube
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Other options are markers, ribbon, beans, dried spaghetti or pasta, pipe cleaners, googly eyes and craft supplies.

• STEPS •

1. Cut the toilet paper roll into 3 equal parts.
2. Decorate each segment with markers, crayons, ribbon, beans, paint, craft supplies and/or construction paper.
3. Glue each part together side-to-side and let dry for 15 minutes.
4. Pick out some pipe cleaners or construction paper, cut out two strips to use as antennae.
5. Glue the antennae onto the head.
6. Paint, cut out eyes from construction paper or glue two googly eyes on the caterpillar's head.
7. The caterpillar is now complete and ready to have some fun!
